South Asian Study Abroad Program Sharing

In response to requests from our member institutions, the Colonial Academic Alliance is pleased to introduce a new collaborative program. Several CAA institutions have agreed to open their study abroad programs in South Asia (typically India) to students from all CAA institutions. The advantages of this program include:

- Greater study abroad options for students
- A significantly wider pool of potential applicants for each program
- The opportunity for students to broaden their experience through learning with students from other institutions



Participating Programs in 2010:

University of Delaware: Winter Session 2010.

- ◆ India ENGL takes place in India with a focus on Indian women writers and observing global business communications in action through site visits. Students will also do volunteer work at an education-oriented NGO. Deadline: Apr. 25, 2009.
- ◆ Around the World LEAD, an intense leadership program in the Middle East, Africa and Asia. Deadline: Apr. 25, 2009.
- ◆ Around the World DIST, focusing on disability in Ghana, the United Arab Emirates, Nepal, and Thailand. Deadline: Sept. 25, 2009.

University of North Carolina Wilmington: Spring 2010. Offering a program on development and globalization (led by a political scientist). Includes a two-week trip to India and pre-departure classes.
